Show-and-Tell Dressage Show Series at Baker School of Riding is formatted to be both educational and competitive. This series is an excellent introduction to showing for new riders, and an opportunity to improve for more experienced riders. For classes, 1-3 5-9, and 12 you will ride your dressage test once for a score. The judge will offer some advice and coaching, and then you will ride your test again for a second score. Each rider will have an approximately 30 minute time slot for their two tests. Classes 4, 10-13 will be run normally. Clinic attire requested, show attire not required.

Prizes will be awarded per class places 1-6, and special awards will go to the high score equitation rider of the day, the most improved rider from their first to second test, and overall high scoring dressage test ride.

Tests will be ridden on a grass outdoor arena, full size for Training level and up, small size for Introductory. A sand/crumb rubber round pen will be available for lunging, and a sand/crumb rubber indoor riding area available for warm ups. In the even of bad weather, all classes will be ridden indoors.

All USDF dressage tests will be the 2019 editions, Western Dressage Tests will all be the 2022 editions, and USEA tests will all be the 2022 editions.

Include a current Negative Coggins test or previous year (if tested within NYS), and a current rabies certificate with entry. All paperwork must be received by the closing date. If the show is oversubscribed, a waiting list will be made.

Refunds: after the closing dates are only available with medical certificate (horse or rider) received within 7 days of the show date.
